

Unique Programs That Set Our School Apart

11-Week Equestrian Program

K–5: Saddle up for smiles! In our 11-week Equestrian Program, children get to spend time with real horses—brushing, walking, and yes, even getting to ride! These are simple, supervised rides designed for fun and confidence building—not formal riding lessons.
